Station 300 – Senior Tournament Series

- 1) You must pay local association dues if not already certified in Summit County USBC. If not paid prior to bowling, bowler scores will be voided.
- 2) Tournament will be handicapped as follows:
 Trio 80% of 720 scratch Doubles 80% of 480 scratch Singles-80% of 240 scratch
- 3) All bowlers must use their highest certified winter average of 21 games or more from the previous season. If there is no certified winter average from the previous season, bowlers will use their highest certified summer average of 21 games or more from the previous season. If there is no certified winter or summer average of 21 games or more from the previous season, bowlers will use their highest certified average of 21 games or more from the current season at time of bowling (bringle aguest and ingsheet). All others must use 240 USBC Rule 319a pertaining to 10 pin increase in current average does not apply. Tournament Management reserves the right to rerate a bowler's average if it is determined the bowler's average was not bowled on a "house shot".
- 4) Report all substitutions to the Tournament Office when signing in.
- 5) Incase of injury, disability, or emergency after a game has started, in Teamor Doubles, a substitute will be permitted if one is available. Handicap shall be prorated according to averages of both bowlers involved. If no substitute is available, the disabled bowler's actual score will count for the frames bowled.
- 6)Entries will be scheduled according to requests if possible and in the order received. The schedule will not be changed by the tournament manager except for emergencies.
- 7)Norefunds of entryfees paid. Entry fee is \$30 per event. "Late Entries" Entry fee for entries received day of the event is \$35 per person, per event. Optional actual prize fund available at the cost of \$5 per person.
- 8) Prizefees returned 100%. Prizes will be based on a minimum of not less than one (1) prize for every seen (7) entries.
 - 9) Entry fees must be paid in full with the submittal of the entry form. All Events is included in your entry fee.
 - 10) Lanes will be assigned by the tournament manager. Check-in time is thirty(30) minutes prior to bowling.
 - 11) Protests and appeals must be inwriting stating the grounds for protest or appeal. A protest involving eligibility or playing rules must be filed with tournament management within worty two (72) hours of the infraction, or prior to tournament prizes being paid, whichever occurs first. The decision of the tournament management shall be final unless a written appeal is filed with the local association or USBC Headquarters within ten (10) days of notification of the tournament management's decision.
 - 12) Tournament play will begin at the stated times on the front of the entry form.
 - 13) PROFESSIONAL PBA CARD CARRIERS: All Bowlers who are Professional PBA Card Carriers at time of BOWLING are Limited to Two (2) on a Three (3) BowlerTeam and One (1) on a Two (2) BowlerTeam (Doubles). Automatic disqualification for failure to comply!
 - 14) At the Tournament Manager's discretion, additional squads may be added during the Tournament prior to the last scheduled squad.
 - 15) All Items not covered by these rules will be referred to USBC rules.

THE ENTRANTS WHOSE NAMES APPEAR HEREON ORTHEIR AUTHORIZED REPLACEMENTS HEREBY AGREE THAT THE SUMMIT COUNTY USBC, ITS OFFICERS AND AGENTS SHALL BE LIABLE ONLY TO THE EXTENT OF RETURNING ENTRY FEES IFAND WHEN THESE ENTRANTS SHALL BE PREVENTED FROM BOWLING ANY EVENT IN THE TOURNAMENTTHROUGH PREMATURE TERMINATION OF THE TOURNAMENT WHICH MAY BE BROUGHT ABOUT BYWAR, NATIONAL EMERGENCY OR EMERGENCIES, OR CASES RELATING THERETO OR RESULTING THEREFROM FIRES, STRIKES, LOCKOUTS, LABOR DIFFICULTIES OR OTHER CAUSES BEYOND CONTROL OF THE SUMMIT COUNTY USBC.
